Summary of the project

A common challenge in Latvian and Lithuanian municipalities is to motivate young people, improve their practical skills and involve them in educational, social and cultural activities. This holds true especially for 'youth at risk' – young people from socially deprived families, early school dropouts and youngsters with addictions or criminal records. YOUTH AT RISK wants to promote social inclusion in Kuldīga and Panevėžys, by equipping youth centres in the project area with artistic tools, musical instruments and recording equipment. By organising creative workshops and developing methodological materials, a total of 120 young people from both towns and rural areas will be able to benefit from improved services at youth centres and more accessible and efficient social inclusion measures.



Overcoming Territorial challenges together

- Purchasing equipment for the Kuldīga & Panevėžys Youth Centres
- Minimise risk of exclusion by organising several workshops
- Involving in total 120 youth at risk from more than 100 households as beneficiaries
