

2nd Call For Proposals Requirements to the projects


Projects must be

- 1. Relevant to the Programme area
- 2. Clearly linked to the Programme
- Clearly expressing the need for cross-border cooperation
- 4. Ensuring durability of the results
- 5. Having added value and innovative approach
- 6. Contributing to the horizontal principles and wider strategies
- Involving relevant project partners that jointly contribute to project implementation
- 8. Ensuring balanced partnership
- 9. Having clear and logically interconnected work plan
- Ensuring the project budget aligns coherently and proportionately with the proposed work plan, main outputs and results

Project duration

Maximal project duration is 24 months.

- · Each project application must have at least
 - one Latvian project partner and
 - one Lithuanian project partner.
- One of partners must be appointed as the Lead Partner

Limitations when the Lead Partner is NGO

total project ERDF <200 000 EUR

>200 000 EUR

- ✓ LP cumulative revenue of the last two financial years (2021, 2022) or from the date of its establishment (if established later) must be at least 25% of the intended ERDF cofinancing of the LP's budget.
- ✓ LP organization must be established not later than in 2021, and
 ✓ LP cumulative revenue of the last two
- LP cumulative revenue of the last two financial years (2021, 2022) must be at least 50% of the intended ERDF co-financing of the total project budget.

Submission of applications

- Deadline: 17:00 on June 21, 2024
- Applications must be submitted via JEMS on https://jems.latlit.eu.
- Application requirements and Applicant's pack are updated compared to 1st Call!

The main changes from the 1st call

Priority I:

- Mandatory output and result are added.
- It is recommended that the equipment costs would not exceed 20% of total project budget.

Priority II:

- For SO 2.1 mandatory output and result are added.
- Adding awareness raising activities is highly recommended.

Priority III:

 Terms for social services and social inclusion measures are explained.

Priority IV:

· Touristic products must be joint.

Investments into equipment and infrastructure

- Submit with the application:
 - Technical documentation prepared in accordance with national legislation for planned (re)construction works. Requirements for submission and requesting missing technical documentation are updated. NEW!
 - Documents for installation of outdoor equipment (stands, fitness equipment, etc.). NEW!
- · For Priority I projects:
 - No investments into infrastructure.
 - It is recommended that equipment costs would not exceed 20% of total project budget. NEW!
- Investments in infrastructure and equipment outside the Programme area are eligible in exceptional cases, if they are well-justified, contribute and directly support project outputs and results. NEW!
- Marking of investments by permanent plaques or billboards is mandatory if total project budget is more than 100 000 EUR. NEW!

Payments to projects

- · No advance payments to projects.
- Payments to the projects will be done on a reimbursement basis.
- Project partners must report on their progress and expenditures every six months.
